TRAFFIC PATTERNS CHANGE AROUND OUR SCHOOLS STARTING AUGUST 5TH

The one-way streets surrounding our two K-8 schools are being resurfaced, restriped and modified to accommodate two-way traffic. Each school has its own pick up and drop off rules. Street maps with directions are online at myriverislands.com.

The diagram to the left indicates the new flow of traffic along Commercial, Marina and Academy Drives.

The streets highlighted will transition from one-way streets to two-way streets with completion scheduled for August 5th. Pay close attention to the directional signs and street markings during this time.
