OPEN LETTER FROM SUSAN DELL'OSSO PRESIDENT, RIVER ISLANDS DEVELOPMENT

As most of our residents know, Lathrop Irrigation District has been providing electrical power to River Islands' schools, residents and commercial buildings since 2011. A public utility, LID has an elected board made up of residents of River Islands, has no shareholders and is a not-for-profit agency.

In May, River Islands saw a glimpse of its green future, when representatives of LID, River Islands Development, the City of Lathrop and Mainspring Energy gathered to dedicate the installation of ten linear generators. These generators —the first installation in any master planned community in the US—represent the launch of LID's plan to deliver clean, high-efficiency, reliable power through the direct conversion of a fuel source like gas into electricity through linear motion provided by linear generators. The net effect is outstanding power conversion efficiency and low carbon emissions.

Enormous thanks go to Curtis Bryant and the LID Staff and Board of Directors, who performed the research and led the team toward a partnership with Mainspring Energy. Curtis, the recently retired General Manager of LID, gave LID twelve years of leadership for the benefit of the residents of River Islands. In addition, Curtis leveraged the knowledge and experience of his many years in the industry to build up a utility district that we can rely on.

At the dedication ceremony, Curtis was quoted as saying "LID is always looking toward the future. Our future is green, dependable, and free of fees from outside agencies. By taking on a project like the Mainspring Linear Generators, we are moving toward establishing a system that can be transitioned to using 100% renewable fuels as they become available." This kind of foresight will pay dividends—both in reduced energy bills and in establishing a stable energy resource for our community—for years to come.

River Islands is always looking ahead for smart solutions to long-term sustainability. Our track record for building strong infrastructure, from our levee system to our lift stations to the size of the conduit in the streets for future internet needs, has been a part of the planning and development of our community from the very beginning.

This installation by LID of state-of-the-art equipment to provide our residences, schools and businesses with clean, reliable power is a perfect complement to our story.

REDWOOD CAFÉ NOW IN LATHROP

All of the four buildings that make up the Redwood Café are now much closer to their final home site in Lathrop!

In early June, each building made the journey from Modesto, across freeways and side streets, then through River Islands until it reached its temporary drop location at Dell'Osso Family Farm. Here, the buildings will be safely stored while construction continues at Redwood Café's permanent home within the Town Center.

At this time, the foundations for the cellar rooms, which will provide a fantastic experience for group dinners and special occasions, are under construction.

The Redwood Café is planned to celebrate its opening in early 2026.

SCHOOL NEWS ALL AROUND RIVER ISLANDS

Lots of expansions and openings are in the works for the students of the River Islands Academies:

The STEAM Academy is under construction to add approximately 250 more seats to the
first school built at River Islands for the August 2025 school year. This expansion should
allow more siblings to attend the same school, and open up more seats for students who are
moving into the River Islands community.



- River Islands High School is completing its administration building and is ready for the addition of 300 students who have just graduated from the community's K-8 schools. This will bring the total student count to over 800 in the 2025-2026 school year. The school will graduate its first senior class in June, 2026.
- The fourth K-8 campus of the River Islands Academies is now planned for its inaugural year to start in the fall of 2026. Located at the corner of Branton Avenue and Welshire Way, west of the high school, the school will offer a complementary curriculum to the three K-8 schools already open in the community. At completion, the school will offer seats for approximately 1,080 students.

DEL WEBB'S LAKEVIEW CLUB WELL UNDERWAY



The Lakeview Club is well underway at River Islands' Del Webb community, promising to bring top-tier recreational and social spaces to one of Northern California's premier active-adult neighborhoods.

This enormous and beautifully-appointed recreation center will serve as the heart of the 55+ neighborhood, featuring a state-of-the-art fitness center, resort-style pool, pickleball and tennis courts, and multi-purpose rooms for clubs, events and gatherings.

The building is expected to be completed in late 2025 with a private Grand Opening planned for Del Webb's residents and prospective homebuyers. The Lakeview Club will open in early 2026.
