**PLEASE READ THE FISHING RULES BELOW
 YOU MUST SIGN TO ACKNOWLEDGE THAT YOU UNDERSTAND THESE RULES
 ANY VIOLATION OF THE RULES WILL LEAD TO REVOCATION OF PERMIT**

1. As a City of Lathrop resident, you must provide a valid driver’s license, City of Lathrop utility bill, Lathrop Irrigation District utility bill or similar official document as proof of residency. RD 2062 may require additional information if these documents cannot be furnished. River Islands at Lathrop residents may fish without additional fees. All other City of Lathrop residents shall pay a \$25 annual fee that will assist in the maintenance of the lakes and fishing areas.
2. Fish may NOT be taken from the lakes. Only CATCH AND RELEASE is allowed.
3. You must present a valid and current City of Lathrop Resident Fishing Permit at all times while fishing and present this Fishing Permit to authorized personnel (River Islands security or law enforcement) when fishing.
4. You are also required to obtain a current California fishing license, signed in ink and displayed (attached to a hat or outer garment) – this is required for all persons aged 16 and over. By signing this application form, you acknowledge that you understand and will abide by California, RD 2062, City of Lathrop and all other applicable laws. *Initials* _____
5. You are permitted to have one outside guest, which may be a minor while fishing. Your guest must obey all other rules and the Fishing Permit holder will be responsible for the actions of their guest. If minors are fishing, a Minor Fishing Authorization Form will also need to be filled out and signed by the Permit Holder.
6. You are consenting to having your picture taken for this permit. The picture will be used on your permit to assist authorized personnel in indemnifying you.
7. You will be provided a map that clearly shows approved fishing areas and “No Fishing” signs will be posted in areas where fishing is not allowed. You may only fish in the designated areas and may not enter private property at any time – trespassers will be subject to additional laws and can be cited or arrested.
8. Onsite River Islands security will check for City of Lathrop Resident Fishing Permits and will enforce the fishing rules you are acknowledging. Any violation of these rules can lead to permanent revocation of this permit and you lose your right to fish. Continued violations by multiple parties may lead to fishing being discontinued and RD 2062 reserves the right to may ban all fishing in the lakes as a result.

By signing below, you acknowledge under penalty of perjury, that you have read the rules provided to you on this form, reviewed and understand the Authorized Lake Map that is attached and agree to abide by all laws, polices and rules of the District, City of Lathrop and State of California.
