A WORD ABOUT DOGGIE ETIQUETTE

One thing that lights up Facebook like nothing else is concerns by residents about those few dog owners who do not maintain a level of concern for others when letting their dogs explore River Islands. In short, all dog owners should remember:

- Dogs should be on leash at all times, unless in an area that expressly states otherwise
- Dog owners should always carry poop scoop bags with them and dispose of them properly
- Dog owners who allow their dogs off leash run the risk of their animals hurting other animals, children or adults who try to break up fighting animals. According to the Center for Disease Control, dog attacks are the Number One health hazard to children under the age of 12.
- Animal services can be called for households who allow their dogs to bark at all hours. The City of Lathrop's website cites 15 minutes of barking as a barking problem.
- All dogs must have current rabies vaccinations and licenses. This is a state law.

SUMMER SOCCER CAMPS LEAD TO LEAGUE PLAY FOR ALL AGES

Starting in early July, River Islands Futbol Club, a private soccer academy, will be offering clinics in advance of the beginning of league play in August. While the playing fields are planted and getting established, all clinics will be held at the field at River Islands Technology Academy.

The mission of River Islands FC is to provide a premier level soccer experience focused on individual player development. Players will be exposed to the technical, tactical, physical and mental aspects of soccer that create successful players.

Ages: This clinic is designed for players ages 5-14. Players will be grouped by ages and gender based on the number of participants.

Training: Players will focus on individual dribbling, passing, shooting and defending skills. Each clinic will cover individual skills and abilities focusing on the individual development of each participant. Players will have an opportunity to apply the learned skills in small side games and full scrimmage environments.



Dates: Week 1 Monday July 9th-Friday July 13th; Week 2 Monday July 16th-Friday July 20th; Week 3 Monday July 23rd-Friday July 27th.

Times: Camp will run from 9 am to 12 pm Monday through Friday Location: River Islands Technology Academy Field – 1175 Marina Drive, Lathrop, CA 95330

Cost: \$115 per player. Sibling Discount of \$15 per sibling signed up

In addition, an all-new program has been created to give the youngest players, ages 3 - 5, an opportunity to have some fun on the field with other children from their own age group.

This is a program for 3-5 year olds that runs once a week for 45 minutes each session. Sessions last 6 weeks. This is a great introduction to the game of soccer for young players. Coaches work on playing games with kids using soccer balls, creating a fun environment. Kids will have a positive first experience as we work to create a passion for the game.

Ages: 3-5 years old

Days: Initial clinics will be run on Tuesdays from 10-10:45 on the mornings of the clinics.
